IN THE SPOTLIGHT

The social distancing rope barriers have been removed from the two middle seating sections in the sanctuary. The barriers remain in place in the outside sections for the time being. The Omaha mask mandate is in force until May 25. Beginning the weekend of May 29-30, masks will be optional.

A Congregational Assembly was held on Sunday, May 16 at 12:00pm in the sanctuary. A financial report was given that showed first quarter income and expenses as well as an update on the Seeds of Hope campaign. A historical review was shared on the planting of GraceHill Church and discussion took place on how to move forward with the property owned by Divine Shepherd at 168th and Giles. The congregation voted to have the Board of Directors engage the services of a real estate agent to gather more information about the possible sale of the land. A follow up Congregational Assembly is being planned for Sunday, June 13th at 12:00pm following the 10:45am service.
