GILES PROPERTY SALE UPDATE

On February 3, 2022, DSLC executed a Purchase Agreement to sell our property at 168th & Giles. Jennie Smith and I have been in regular contact with the buyer's agent, and we have been assured that the "inspection" process is proceeding as expected for the buyer. The

purchasers have engaged an attorney to prepare a re-zoning and plan development application for the property. We have provided copies of all pertinent property information and documentation to the buyer. The residence tenant's attorney has also advised us that the tenant is planning to vacate the house in April. Moreover, per agreement with the buyer, the farm tenant will be retained to plant and harvest a crop during this growing season.
